

**St. John Vianney**



I love you, O my God. And my only desire is to love you Until the last breath of my life. I love you, O my infinitely lovable God, and I would rather die loving you, then live without loving you. I love you Lord & the only grace I ask is to love you eternally... My God, if my tongue cannot say in every moment tat I love you. I want my heart to repeat it to you as often as I draw breath.

**John Vianney (born Jean-Marie Vianney and later Jean-Marie-Baptiste Vianney 8 May 1786 – 4 August 1859) was a French Catholic priest often referred to as the *Curéd'Ars* ("the parish priest of Ars"). He is known for his priestly and pastoral work in his parish in Ars, France, resulting in the radical spiritual transformation of the community and its surroundings. Catholics note his saintly life, mortification, persevering ministry in the sacrament of confession, and ardent devotion to Blessed Virgin Mary. He was canonized in 1925 and his feast day is August 4. He is the patron saint of parish priests.**
