St. Ignatius of Loyola (born 1491, Loyola, Castile [Spain]—died July 31, 1556, Rome [Italy]; canonized March 12, 1622; feast day July 31) was a Spanish theologian and mystic who became one of the most influential figures in the Roman Catholic Counter-Reformation in the 16th century. In 1534 he formed a religious brotherhood in Paris known as the Society of Jesus (Jesuits), which received official papal recognition in 1540.
