Saint John Henry Newman was born in London in 1801. As an Anglican clergyman he was influential in the Oxford Movement. He was received into full communion with the church by Blessed Dominic of the Mother of God on this day in 1845 while living at Littlemore, Oxford. He was beatified by Pope Benedict XVI in Birmingham in September 2010 and canonised by Pope Francis in 2019.
