**Mission Sunday**

Mission is a popular theme in the Church today. We are encouraged to be missionary disciples and Pope Francis urges our communities to live ‘in a missionary key’ (Evangelii Gaudium, 33). This kind of missionary activity is personal and local. World Mission Sunday, however, reminds us that mission goes beyond ourselves, our parishes and our diocese. It is a mission to the world, fulfilling the words of the prophet Habakkuk, ‘For the earth shall be filled with the knowledge of the glory of the Lord’ (Hab 2:14). The Pope’s charity which supports the Church’s mission to the world is called Missio. This global charity draws our attention to the parts of the world where the Church is growing and vibrant, where it is poor and in need and where it is suffering from persecution and difficulty. Missio supports these areas by encouraging us to pray and to assist financially, providing for specific needs in furthering the Church’s mission. You can help by prayer and by donating to the second collection this weekend. Missio is part of our mission.

- **Kim Leadbeater** the Labour MP for Spen Valley, has introduced a bill to assisted suicide, which will be voted on by MPs on the **29 November**. This attempt to legalise state-sponsored killing comes just weeks after the Health Secretary said that the NHS is “in crisis”. The elderly and vulnerable are already at risk due to the winter fuel payment being cut, and disabled people are struggling to access the care and support they need.
