- Oppose assisted suicide In-person and online discussion get the Zoom details, please email <u>stnewmanparish.wmids@rcaob.org.uk</u> Kim Leadbeater the Labour MP for Spen Valley, has introduced a bill to assisted suicide, which will be voted on by MPs on the 29 November. This attempt to legalise state-sponsored killing comes just weeks after the Health Secretary said that the NHS is "in crisis".
