St Thomas born in 1225 . Joined the Dominican order .He is considered one of Greatest philosophers and theologians of all Times. St Thomas gained the title of 'Angelic Doctor' Pope Leo XIII declared him Patron of Catholic schools. His monumental work 'Summa Theologiae was still unfinished when he died.





St John Bosco founded the Salesian society, named in honour of St Francis de Sales and the Daughters of Mary, Help of Christians His lifework was the welfare of young boys and Girls, hence, the tile, 'Apostle of Youth' was given to him
