The two brothers were born in Thessalonica, Cyril in 827–828, and Methodius in 815–820. They are credited with devising the Glagolitic alphabet, the first alphabet used to transcribe Old Church Slavonic. Both brothers are venerated in the Eastern Orthodox Church as saints with the title of "equal-to-apostles". In 1880, Pope Leo XIII introduced their feast into the calendar of the Roman Rite of the Catholic Church. In 1980, the first Slav pope, Pope John Paul II declared them co-patron saints of Europe, together with Benedict of Nursia.
