# Children's Liturgy of the Word Group [CLG] -

This is a wonderful opportunity for us to make the readings and the Gospel more meaningful for the younger children in our St John Fisher Parish.

#### REFLECTION

We pause during Mass - for example after "Let us pray" after the Readings - a few moments for reflection, prayer, "Reading without reflection is arid and reflection without reading is mistaken - prayer without reflection is halfhearted or empty - and reflection without prayer is rare and miraculous" - as one spiritual writer put it recently. In other words, we need food, that is, the word of God, to fuel our reflection. Our reflection leads to prayer, as we praise and thank God.

FOUR STEPS - reading/reflection/prayer/union with God our pauses are not meant to be wasted.
