HANDS – FACE – SPACE

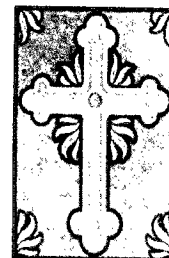
Wash your hands – cover your face – keep your distance.
