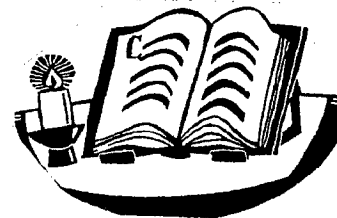

On the feast of the Assumption we honour the life of our Blessed Lady. What can we LEARN FROM IT? It is one thing to admire achievement; it is another thing to look beyond it and see how it came about. We may see a great pianist or singer and think, "I'd like to be able to do that." All we see is the beautiful performance on stage. We may forget the dedication, discipline, study and hard work that went into making that performance possible. It takes a lot of hard work to develop strength of character, toughness of mind, tenderness of heart, and generosity of spirit. Our purpose is to honour the great and beautiful life that Mary lived. The only way we can do that is to follow the example of her life and to place the emphasis where she placed it -in hearing the word of God and keeping it.

The Assumption of our Lady into Heaven.

Mary is taken up to Heaven – Every one of us feels the sense of satisfaction after having done a good job - whatever the task. We all have a job to do — a vocation to fulfill. We must make it meaningful for ourselves and for those around us. In order to do so, we need images to go by. We have a beautiful image in Mary - simply because she did nothing spectacular but nevertheless had a very meaningful life. Mary experienced the darkness of faith, as each one of us has at some time or other. She endured the anxieties of a mother who did not always understand a Son who has great ideals and takes frightening risks. She was a woman of sorrow following her Son, harrassed and humiliated on the Way of the Cross. BUT, she is also an image for our future - she is now with God - she gives us hope that when our time comes God will say to each one of us – "WELL DONE, MY GOOD AND FATHFUL SERVANT - COME AND SHARE YOUR FATHER'S JOY".
