REFELCTION FOR THE SECOND SUNDAY OF LENT This is my San the beloved - LISTEN TO HIM. The season of Lent prepares us for the renewal of our baptism.

The celebrant touches the ears of newly baptised in the ceremony saying - "The Lord Jesus made the deaf hear and the dumb speak, May he touch your ears to hear his word and your mouth to proclaim his faith to the praise and glory of God the Father".

LENT is that season when we begin again; we listen to God's Word — LENT is a time for progress.

MOUNTAINS are wonderful, power-filled places. Mountains offer a wider view. In the Bible the mountains are associated with divine encounters and with visions which inspired life.
