A REFLECTION FOR EASTER

- On Christmas Day Jesus was born - the Lord came down to earth. To all He brought the Good News of God's Peace.
- On Palm Sunday he was greeted by the crowds who waved palm branches -they shouted - "Hosanna to the King".
- On Holy Thursday at the Last Supper he knelt and washed the feet of his disciples as a sign of friendship, as a sign of service to others. He gave himself in the gifts of bread and wine - for the feast so that all could eat - so that all could rejoice.
- On Good Friday Jesus died on the Cross at Calvary - after being savagely beaten and tortured. On the Cross he took on all the burdens and the sins of our lives. On the Cross he opened his arms to give us all the treasures of God's love.
- On Easter Day Jesus rose from the dead - he is alive for evermore. He is with us each day - he is always on the side of life. He is the sign of new life - a new way to live, a new way to care for others. Jesus has risen - as he said he would.

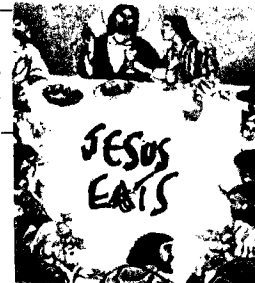
Dear Friends and Parishioners –
