

DEVOTIONS FOR LENT- THE STATIONS OF THE CROSS

Find a little time this Lent to walk with Jesus on his Way of the Cross.... It is a story of love that knew no limit. The fourteen - now fifteen - traditional stations on the Way of the Cross begin with the condemnation of Jesus by Pilate. We reflect on the frailty and the weakness of human nature. Then Jesus takes up his Cross and we are able to give thanks for his strength and Three times we think of Jesus falling under the weight of the Cross. We pause to imagine the meeting with his Mother Mary - the help he received from Simon of Cyrene - the kindness and goodness of Veronica - the compassion and the tears of the Women of the City of Jerusalem. Finally, there is the humiliation of being stripped of his clothes on Calvary being nailed and bound to the Cross. Jesus is then abandoned by his friends and dies a criminal death - Jesus is taken down from the Cross and is buried in a tomb. It is a terrible and tragic story - yet it is a story of Love that ends in LIFE. Recall at the end the great event of the Resurrection - what it means for us -THE LORD HAS RISEN.

Have you ever noticed when you made a promise that it takes two people to make and keep it? This is because promises are about giving and receiving. Promises are never free samples and, like Abraham, they take us across unknown paths. Responsible ownership of our promises is a faith choice to share the Lord and 'to bear the hardship' for the sake of the promise.
