SIXTH SUNDAY OF EASTER - YEAR C

Strengthened by Jesus' assurance of God the Father's love for us all, we bring our needs, the needs of the world, the prayers of the Church, to the One who gives us life, to the One who is the fount of all holiness.

1. *We pray for all who exercise authority in the Church like Paul and Barnabas, Peter and James that they will continue to promote the freedom of the Gospel and the dignity of all peoples.*

2. *We pray for people throughout the world who lack food and shelter because of drought, famine, war, or injustice in their country. May rich nations be moved to increase their aid donations.*

3. *We pray again for peace in our broken world that the gift of the Risen Christ will be enjoyed by the many people who are disabled by violence and oppressed by its power. We remember those too who are overwhelmed by the pressures of life - may they come to experience Christ's power and comfort.*

4. *Our Gospel speaks to us of the Holy Spirit as sent to teach us everything. We ask the Holy Spirit to bless the work of all involved in nourishing the faith through adult religious education.*

5. *We pray for ourselves that our sharing in this Mass, in the Lord's Supper, will make us more sensitive to God who lives in us - and more aware of the needs of others.*

6. *We pray for all those whose lives have been destroyed this week because of disaster and violence. May the safety and the security of all people be the first priority in nation's plans for the future.*

7. *In this the month of May, we ask the prayers of Mary - Hail Mary*

8. *In a moment of silent reflection, we pray for our Parish, our homes, our families, and our friends.*

God our Father, mindful of your great love for us, we entrust our world and its needs to your care and your protection. Let the gift of your divine life continue to grow in our hearts. Hear the prayers of our troubled hearts, and let us know each day the power and strength of living in your peace. We ask this prayer as we ask all our prayers through our Lord Jesus Christ your Son who lives and reigns with you, the Father, and the Holy Spirit, one God, our God, forever and ever. Amen.
